#### 5. Glebe Field:

Risk Assessments: Debby will be making appropriate arrangements with Rory of MCC Youth Service tomorrow (5<sup>th</sup> May).

#### 6. Alternative heating system project:

Jocelyn, Jeff and Glenn Hall visited the Usk Scout Hut with Nigel Meeks and were impressed with the air-exchange heating system. It has the advantages of being relatively quiet, economical with regard to electricity usage and simple/inexpensive to install.

The general opinion was that it would be a good way of providing heat to the main hall, which is currently the main area that costs the most in oil bills. The underfloor manifold which pumps hot water around the main hall could be turned off leaving other rooms to continue being heated by the underfloor system or in taking some heat from the air-exchange system.

It was agreed that this appears to be a cost-effective option compared with ground-source and/or solar, as the air-exchange system would involve very little disruption (the oil boiler would remain) and low installation costs.

It was decided that we should get a survey carried out by the contractor to measure how much heat would be required in the hall, and to establish what this would mean in the number of units provided, and estimated running costs.

Action: Jocelyn to arrange with Glenn.

### 7. Funding/grant applications, etc:

No further action but it was agreed that we will need to seek funding for an air-exchange heating system once we know the costs.

### 8. Maintenance, cleaning, etc.:

Clear all rubbish from site/car park/playground/field/woods and take to dump: George

Re-fix curtains that have come adrift. New curtain rings required for some curtains (Jeff)

Strim/spray weeds around building and mow lawn: George/Dave ths
