Minutes of the Meeting of Llanishen Parochial Hall Management Committee, held on Wednesday 6th July 2011.

1. Public Participation:

None

2. Minutes of last meeting to be agreed:

The minutes of the last meeting were agreed as a true record. Action:

George to forward minutes to Steve McNally for uploading to the hall website.

3. Matters Arising from last Minutes and not on the agenda:

None.

4. Finance:

a. Proposed Handover:

Jeff is now not under so much pressure of work and will therefore carry on as Treasurer. The proposed transfer to Angela is now postponed.

b. Treasurer's report:

Jeff provided copies of the cumulative income and expenditure schedule, as at 12^{th} June. Total recorded income to date was £5,903.04. Expenditure was £5,626.57, leaving a current surplus of £276.47. Some cash is still to come in.

c. Outstanding bills, cheques, etc.: Jeff has arranged for a direct debit rebate with Swalec. Forms were signed

d. Cheque signatories' mandate:

Forms obtained from bank and details completed.

e. Insurance:

Jocelyn has received a renewal notice from our insurers, No increase in price (third year of three-year fixed term) despite recent claims for drainage and window repairs. It was agreed to renew the policy.

5. Glebe Field:

Risk Assessments:

Debby is dealing with Monmouthshire Youth Service re possible requirement for a risk assessment for the Glebe Field.

Since the meeting, Debby has established that current notices are sufficient for purpose and that risk assessments would only be required for events on the field as and when required.

6. Alternative heating system project:

It was agreed that we contact the air-exchange system supplier and ask for a detailed survey and quotation for the hall. The possibility of solar energy might be considered at a later date but the air-exchange system was considered to be a priority item before the winter.

7. Funding/grant applications, etc:

Jeff has obtained an application form from the Welsh Government's CFAP small grants scheme. It was agreed that we should seek funding from this scheme to part-fund the air-exchange system.

8. Maintenance, cleaning, etc.:

Jobs still outstanding are as follows:

Finish re-laying bricks on damaged barbecue (Glenn).

Re-fix louvre on boiler-room door (George).

Replace broken door handles/latches and/or replace with pull-handles and push-plates.

Finish painting and cladding the storage container: Leave until later in year (Peter Copp).

Curtains on internal doors keep coming adrift. It was agreed that roller blinds would be a better option. To follow this up.

Immersion heater anti-corrosion unit still not fixed or replaced.

Fascia and roof tile need fixing.

Glebe field needs mowing in early August, in time for Village Challenge. Actions:

George to ask Glenn if he could finish off the barbecue brickwork George to fix boiler-room door.

George to sort out replacement/repair of anti-corrosion device (ongoing). Jocelyn to get quotes for fixing fascia and loose roof tile (ongoing). Jocelyn to arrange with Ian Morgan for mowing of Glebe Field

Jocelyn will arrange meets and greets outside of the meeting.
